and the strength to complete it.*

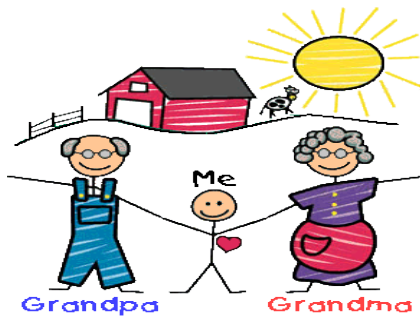

Everyone is encouraged to register for next year's Extended Care Program. Our new Extended Day program will be run by the Blue Ash YMCA **HERE on the SVF Campus!!**

The YMCA is offering **FREE REGISTRATION** for next year **through the month of April!** If you **turn in your paperwork to the school office by April 28th**, you will NOT be charged a registration fee for school year 2017-2018. Remember – you never know when an emergency may arise and you might need to use this service. The **Y will not be able to offer same day registration/service next year**, so we recommend registering now, while it's FREE, and **make sure you're covered for any unexpected needs** that may arise next school year. Registration packets were sent home with our current Extended Day Families last week. If you're not a current Extended Day Family but are interested, you can stop by the office to pick up a packet or call and we'll send a packet home with your child.

There are **vouchers and financial assistance available** for those who need it. Everyone is encouraged to apply for the voucher, even if you don't think you'd qualify. If you receive a denial letter, you can take this to Brittany at the YMCA and she will be able to assist you with a scholarship application through the Y.
