- **Registration Reminder**-Registration forms and the **\$100.00 fee per student for current families** for the 2020-2021 school year were due on **Monday, February 3rd**. It is important to act soon to hold your child's spot for next year. **Open registration for new families began Monday Feb. 3rd – Preschool is already filled & Kindergarten is filling up fast!**
- You will need to **complete the regular school registration form for 2020-2021** and submit this along with your **\$100.00 fee per child** before any scholarship documents will be submitted to the State of Ohio.

- **School Registration forms can be turned into the Parish Office.**
- **EdChoice Traditional & Expansion Scholarships** – It is NOW TIME to start completing your **Ed Choice RENEWAL forms!** You can download the renewal form from the Ohio Department of Education website under the parent's tab or go to the link below. In addition to the **renewal application** form you must also submit **proof of residency** (most recent utility bill) **to the school office**. If you are applying for Low Income Status or the Expansion version of the Ed Choice Program - you will also need to **MAIL the "Income Verification" form and ALL supporting documents to the State of Ohio** – address is found on the bottom of the "Income Verification" form.
- **Due to the state mandated closure of the school & offices WE WILL BE CONTACTING YOU VIA EMAIL, as soon as a plan is in place, as to WHERE/HOW you will be able to turn your forms into School. Please be watching your email/texts from us closely over these next 3 weeks for UPDATES!**

Lenten Fasting and Abstinence Guidelines: For many centuries, it has been the custom of the Church for Catholics to fast and abstain from meat on particular days during the penitential season of Lent. Here is a summary of the fasting regulations for your reference: **Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of abstinence from meat and days of fast (which is often described as limiting yourself to a simple full meal). All other Fridays of the season of Lent are days of abstinence from meat.** The law of abstinence binds all Catholics over 14 years of age. The law of fasting binds all Catholics from their 18th year until the beginning of their 60th year.
