SVF is administering the Iowa Assessments to grades 1-7 and the Cognitive Abilities Test (CogAT) to grades 2,5,6 &7

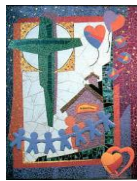
### The testing dates continue through March 16.

Testing time can be an anxious time for students, as their regular schedule is interrupted. You can help our children alleviate some of this anxiety by doing the following:

- Talk to your child/ren about testing and reassure them in a positive way.
- Remain calm and discuss the confidence you have in your child/ren. Remind them that they don't need to study for these tests.
- Give your child/ren a nutritious breakfast each day of the test, but don't make an issue if they refuse to eat.
- Try to keep the morning routine the same.
- Make sure your child/ren gets a good night sleep each night.
- Celebrate the end of testing for yourself and your child/ren.

**STATE TESTING** for Ed Choice and Jon Peterson students in grades 3-8 will be **March 26-April 27**. **Please be sure not to schedule appointments for your children during this time period.**

- **Edchoice and Edchoice Expansion Scholarships**- Renewal forms should have been mailed to your home by now. You can also download the renewal form from the Ohio Department of Education website under the parent's tab. In addition to the renewal application form you must also submit proof of residency (most recent utility bill).
