STATE TESTING for Ed Choice and Jon Peterson students in grades 3-8 will be **March 26-April 17**. **Please be sure not to schedule appointments for your children during this time period.**

- **Edchoice and Edchoice Expansion Scholarships**- Renewal forms should be mailed to your home and should be arriving very soon. You can also download the renewal form from the Ohio Department of Education website under the parent's tab. In addition to the renewal application form you must also submit proof of residency (most recent utility bill). You are still expected to complete the regular school registration form for 2019-2020 and submit this along with your \$100.00 fee per child.
- **Jon Peterson Scholarship** - Please be sure to hand in your renewal forms (which were to have been mailed by the state to current scholarship students) so that they may be submitted online by our office. You are still expected to complete the regular school registration form for 2019-2020 and submit this along with your \$100.00 fee per child.

Ohio | Department of Education - **EdChoice**

Parents with children using state funded scholarships can directly access their child's scholarship information by setting up a Parent Portal account with the Ohio Department of Education. The secure log-in is called a SAFE account. Each parent can create their own SAFE account by going to the Ohio Dept. of Ed. Website.

You will need your state of Ohio ID or driver's license available when setting up the SAFE account.
